Burudyara tower crane removal



Works notice — Monday 6 January 2025



Increase in construction traffic

There will be an increase in construction traffic on Wednesday 8 January 2025 as work is undertaken to dismantle and remove the tower crane from the Burudyara building site.

The work will be carried out over one day. The crane will be dismantled in sections, with a mobile crane loading those sections onto semi-trailers for removal.

During the work, the mobile crane and semi-trailers will enter Concord Hospital grounds at Gate 4 on Boronia Street and travel to the site via the project entry gates and the shared access road through the P5 staff car park. To facilitate the entry of the semi-trailers, four parking spaces outside the Red Cross building will be closed for the day.

The trucks will reverse up Hospital Lane to the Burudyara – Concord Forensic Mental Health Unit site using the existing contraflow arrangements, under the guidance of traffic control staff. Once loaded, the semi-trailers will exit the site and the hospital grounds via the same route.

Pedestrian and motorist access to Hospital Lane will be available throughout the work but will be blocked intermittently to allow loading and removal of crane sections. To co-ordinate truck movements and minimise disruption, traffic controllers will be in place at the intersection of Nullawarra Avenue and Boronia Street, at the project entry gates in the P5 car park and at three locations on Hospital Lane.

Emergency vehicles will continue to have priority during the work.

If the work cannot proceed on Wednesday 8 January, contingencies are in place for it to take place on Thursday 9 January or Friday 10 January.

Key impacts

- The Hospital Lane contraflow will be in operation, with intermittent closures to allow for semi-trailer movements and loading.
- Increased traffic movements through Concord Hospital Gate 4 and the P5 staff car park.
