

# Burudyara generator installation

Works notice — Monday 16 June 2025



Hospital Lane will be closed for several hours on Thursday 19 June 2025 as work is undertaken to install a new generator for Burudyara – Concord Forensic Mental Health Unit.

The work is scheduled to begin shortly after 9am with the arrival of mobile crane that will lift the new generator into position between the new facility and the existing Jara Building.

The three car spaces at the entrance of the Jara Unit will be cordoned off before work begins to make space for the crane's operations.

Project staff will also ensure no staff are in the northern office wing or the switch room of Jara while the lift takes place (duration of approximately 30 minutes).

The mobile crane and a truck carrying the generator will enter Concord Hospital grounds at Gate 4 on Boronia Street and travel to the site via the project entry gates and the shared access road through the SP5 car park.

To co-ordinate truck and crane movements and minimise disruption, traffic controllers will be in place at four locations on Hospital Lane.

A smaller section of Hospital Lane will remain closed to all traffic except emergency vehicles while the work is taking place. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout under the direction of traffic controllers.

## Key impacts

- Hospital Lane will remain closed to all but emergency vehicles.
- Three Jara car park spaces will be closed for duration of work.
- Pedestrian access along Hospital Lane will be retained under direction of traffic controllers.
- Some noise from the crane.
- Some construction traffic movements through Concord Hospital Gate 4 and the SP5 car park.
